KEY POINTS

 This policy pertains to post-secondary students completing practice education enrolled in educational institutions with a current educational affiliation agreement in place with Northern Health (NH).

POLICY

For student practice education, NH has endorsed the BC Academic Health Council's standard provincial guidelines referred to as the Practice Education Guidelines.

In the event that there is a conflict between the provincial standards and NH Policies, the existing NH Policy takes precedence.

All students, while participating in learning experiences, must be adequately prepared, oriented to the practice setting, and be familiar with NH Policies and Clinical Practice Standards.
