All research conducted within, or for Northern Health (NH) must be approved by the Research Review Committee (RRC). The RRC is also directed to consider the impact the NH organization. As such, the researcher must obtain operational approval as p for Research Approval to the RRC. This ensures that there is knowledge about and research happening in the region, as well as acceptance of risk and acknowledgeme




